GPA Midstream Association strongly supports President Trump's nomination of Andrew Wheeler to be Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).

Andrew Wheeler brings a wealth of legislative and regulatory expertise to EPA. He is a seasoned environmental and energy policy expert who knows how important sound science-based regulations are to creating American jobs while protecting human health and our environment.

GPA Midstream supports this nomination as it has served the U.S. energy industry since 1921. GPA Midstream is composed of nearly 100 corporate members of all sizes that are engaged in the gathering and processing of natural gas into merchantable pipeline gas, commonly referred to in the industry as "midstream activities." Such processing includes the removal of impurities from the raw gas stream produced at the wellhead, as well as the extraction for sale of natural gas liquid products ("NGLs") such as ethane, propane, butane, and natural gasoline. GPA Midstream members account for more than 90 percent of the NGLs produced in the United States from natural gas processing. Our members also operate hundreds of thousands of miles of domestic gas gathering lines and are involved with gathering, storing, transporting, and marketing natural gas and NGLs. GPA Midstream is the primary advocate for a sustainable midstream industry focused on enhancing the viability of natural gas, natural gas liquids and crude oil.

GPA Midstream strongly supports the nomination of Andrew Wheeler to serve as Administrator of EPA and thanks you for your consideration of his nomination.
