Measurement & Quantity Determination (MAQD)

Purpose

Ensures GPA Midstream exercises influence and ownership over measurement standards.

Scope

Develop new and maintain existing standards, procedures, and methods relative to measurement and quantity determination.

Area of Responsibility

- Provide a forum for measurement personnel from member companies to share practices related to measurement and quantity determination.
- Develop, comment, participate, inform, review, and revise technical standards, procedures, and methods assigned to this committee.
- Interact with other GPA Midstream Committees and GPA Midstream and GPSA member companies.
 - Survey the needs for technical information, procedures, and standards relating to measurement in the midstream industry.
 - Identify, support, evaluate, and incorporate research and testing for measurement activities.
 - Provide resources and support for the GPA Midstream School of Gas Chromatography.
 - Keep apprised of the regulatory environment as it pertains measurement and quantity determination.

 - American Gas Association (AGA)
 - ASTM International (ASTM)
